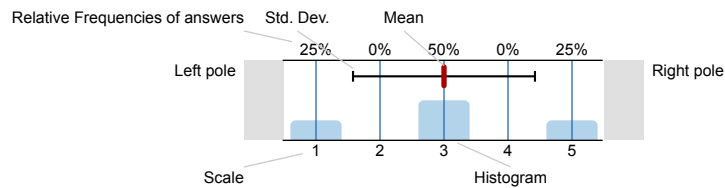

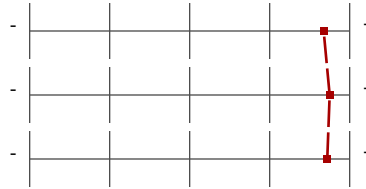

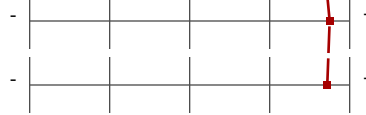

4.1) What were the best features of the course (e.g. readings, examinations, topics covered)?

4.2) What were the worst features of the course?

As I mentioned, I believe the course is extremely well constructed, ~~inimicable~~ although I think it could be interesting to read about the circuit courts more throughout the syllabus to get a little more of his perspective.
